1) All entries will be lined up on N. 14th Street and west on Saunders Street behind H-E-B. **2)** The Parade will end on Lovers Lane at Marshall Street. **3)** No candy or other items may be thrown from a vehicle or float. Candy may ONLY be thrown by walkers. **4)** Judging Divisions will be assigned by the parade committee: Division I-Churches, Division II-Other, Division III-Organizations, Division IV-Businesses

2017 CHRISTMAS PARADE REGULATIONS

1. Organizations and entries are responsible for providing vehicle(s) and trailer required to enter a float in the Parade. Please remember when designing and building your entry: the stability of the platform and the tow vehicle; weather; all aspects of safety for your entry are extremely important.
2. Entrants are responsible for faulty or unsafe equipment. Motorized vehicles must have current liability insurance.
3. All drivers in the parade must have a valid State-issued Drivers License.
4. The Gatesville Chamber of Commerce assumes no liability for damage or injury caused by floats, vehicles, or other entries/participants entered in the parade.
5. Each float must have persons walking on the outer sides of floats as "outriders" to ensure spectator safety.
6. Horses or other animals should have 'disposal' persons assigned to pickup animal droppings.
7. **NO CANDY OR OTHER ITEMS** may be thrown from a vehicle or float. Only outriders are permitted to throw candy or other items, providing items are thrown away from the parade convoy. If hazards are foreseen or spectator safety is compromised, items may be prohibited.
8. **NO ENTRY MAY HAVE A LIVE SANTA CLAUS.** Any float, vehicle, or entry that violates this policy will be removed from the parade line-up. There will only be one "real" Santa Claus, which is provided by the Chamber of Commerce at parade end.
9. Dignitaries must furnish their own vehicle and identification signs.
10. Line-up time is 8:00 a.m. for judged entries and 10:00 a.m. for all others. The Chamber of Commerce information booth/table will be at the corner of 14th St and Main.
11. During the parade, please maintain two (2) car lengths between your entry and the entry in front of you to ensure consistent flow of the parade
12. **NO STREET VENDORS ALLOWED** on the parade route without the written consent of the Gatesville Chamber of Commerce.
13. Parade participants may be picked up at the corner of Lovers Lane and Marshall Street following the parade.

JUDGING

Entries must be registered with the Chamber to be eligible to compete for awards. Judges decisions will be final. Entries will be judged in-line according to the following criteria and awards will be presented at step-off.

Originality:..... 1 to 20 points

Detail:.....1 to 20 points

Use of Color:..... 1 to 20 points

Creativity:.....1 to 20 points

General Effect: 1 to 20 points

BONUS for Sound or Live Characters: 1 to 20 points
