Vendor Participation Rules

- Vendor understands no overnight accommodations are included in booth rental. Vendor should make arrangements accordingly.
- Vendor understands that spaces will be indoors in vacant buildings around the square, in existing businesses on the square, or outdoors in the pocket park next door to Graves Florist.
- Booths are empty spaces. Vendor will be required to bring any supplies or equipment necessary (tables/chairs/etc) to setup booths.
- Vendor participation is subject to Corks & Kegs committee.
- IF vendor rejects these rules or fails to observe these rules, this may cause dismissal of the vendor from the event.
- Vendor is responsible for acquiring a Tax ID and clearly posting such ID within their booth. Vendor is also responsible for collecting tax as required.
- Vendor is responsible for cleaning up rented booth space during and after the event.
- Vendor must notify the Corks & Kegs committee of any power needs at the time of placing an application.

Vendor Details

- Market Space will vary. Location may be indoors in vacant buildings or businesses around the Coryell County Square, or in the open air pocket park next to Graves Florist.
- Set up will be Saturday, November 16th 2019, starting at 11 am. All vendors must be completely set up by 3 pm. The event will conclude at 8 pm, vendors have one hour to tear down their space.
- Once applications are approved, payment is due within 2 days, and are non-refundable. If payment is not made within 2 days of approval, the space may be forfeited.
- Point of sell franchises will be limited to one of each type (ie: Scentsy, Color Street, etc). However the chamber has no control over established businesses on the square partnering with vendors.
- Cost is \$50 for chamber members, and \$75 for non-chamber members
